NAPLAN

On Monday we had approximately 90 students from Year 7 and 9 receive certificates to celebrate their fantastic results in NAPLAN 2026.

Students received a certificate from the school if

- their performance exceeded the expectations set for their specific year level in one of the test
- they achieved high relative growth. This means that a student has made progress in the top 25% of all students across the state who started with the exact same score two years prior.

Congratulations to all of our students who received a certificate and watch out for the celebration luncheon in Term 4.

Careers

CSC Students Experience the World of Work

Cobram Secondary College offers Year 9 and 10 students a range of opportunities to experience real workplaces. During their semester of Careers and Work, students complete a week-long work experience placement in each term. These weeks are set aside without CATs or major classwork, allowing students to fully immerse themselves in the workplace. Students can also elect to complete Wednesday Work Experience for a semester or the full year.

This term, students gained hands-on experience across environmental management, community services, tourism, hospitality, early childhood education, healthcare, retail, real estate, libraries, pharmacy, cabinetry, engineering and the automotive industry.

When asked whether work experience in cabinetry was what she expected, Casey Larsen replied, "This was better than I imagined."

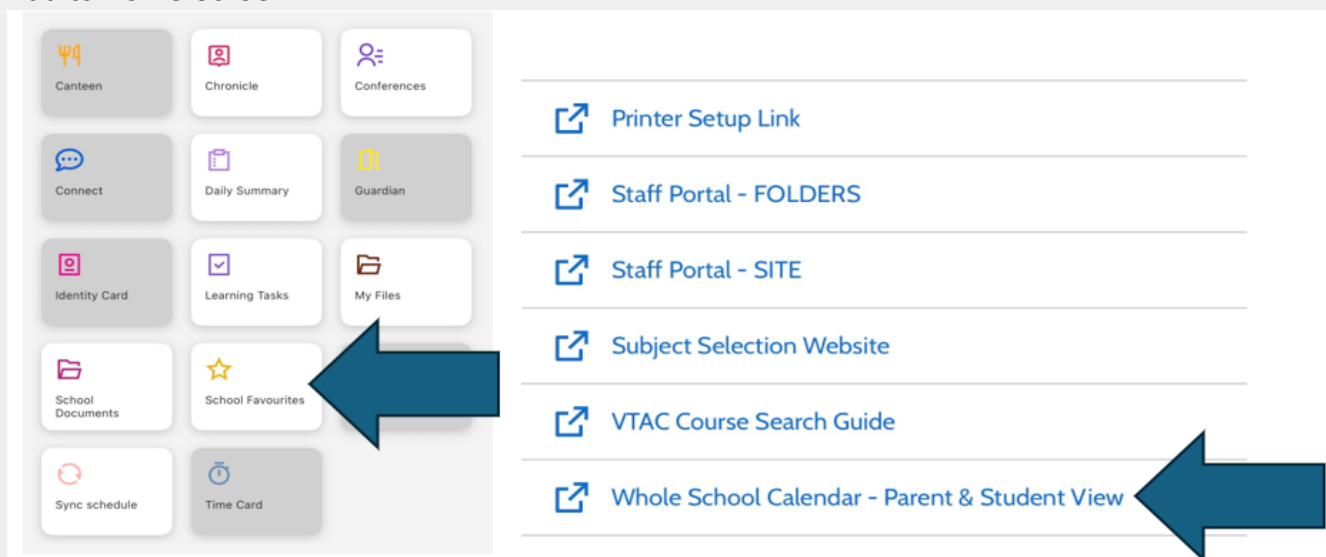
